WHEREAS, Christina Battalia received the honor of becoming a Certified Municipal Clerk from the International Institute of Municipal Clerks (IIMC) and is a Registered Municipal Clerk with the New York State Town Clerks Association; she was also a member of the Westchester County Records Committee and a member of the New York State Archives Records Advisory Council; and
