(Port Chester, NY) – Ahead of families and friends gathering for Passover and Easter, New York State Senator Shelley B. Mayer announced her office will be distributing nearly 5,000 free COVID-19 test kits throughout Senate District 37.

I encourage my neighbors to take the steps to protect their loved ones from COVID-19, including testing before attending holiday parties.”

Monday, April 11, from 3 to 5 p.m.

- New Rochelle Public Library - 1 Library Plaza, New Rochelle

Monday, April 11 from 4 to 6 p.m.

- Grinton I. Will Library - 1500 Central Park Avenue, Yonkers

Test kits will be limited to two per household while supplies last. Each kit contains two at-home antigen rapid tests.
