College, State University of New York remains true to its mission by bringing together students in the liberal arts, sciences, and conservatory arts programs in a vibrant, creative community where in-depth knowledge grows from open-minded engagement, questioning boundaries, and inspiring possibility; and

WHEREAS, As of the Fall of 2021, total student enrollment was 3,446 undergraduate students and 83 graduate students, roughly 83% of whom are New York residents; the remainder come from 40 states and 24 foreign countries; and

WHEREAS, These students are offered 47 majors, 32 minors, four graduate majors, artist diplomas and performers certificates; and

WHEREAS, Today, under the visionary guidance of President Dr. Milagros Pena, Purchase College, State University of New York stands proud and prominent, always looking to the future and the needs of those it serves; now, therefore, be it
