COMMEMORATING the 25th Anniversary of the Chamber
Alliance of the Mohawk Valley

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body to recognize that the quality and character of life in the communities across New York State are reflective of the concerned and dedicated efforts of those organizations and individuals who would devote themselves to the welfare of the community and its citizenry; and

WHEREAS, Attendant to such concern, and in full accord with its long-standing traditions, this Legislative Body is justly proud to commemorate the 25th Anniversary of the Chamber Alliance of the Mohawk Valley; and

WHEREAS, The Chamber Alliance of the Mohawk Valley was established with seven members in 1997; today, this vital organization consists of 23 chambers of commerce and affiliate partners, which strive to represent and promote the collective interests of the business community of the Mohawk Valley, that geographic area which includes, but is not limited to, Herkimer County, Oneida County, Madison County, Otsego County, Fulton County, and Montgomery County; and

WHEREAS, As an umbrella organization, the Chamber Alliance of the Mohawk Valley diligently works to address concerns of the regional business community including tourism, economic development, health care,
