WHEREAS, Miko Amican is a member of Boy Scouts of America Troop 45, Mineola, New York; and

WHEREAS, Miko Amican's Eagle Project benefited the NYU Langone Hospital (Long Island)-Child Life Program; with the help of his fellow Boy Scouts and leaders, he assembled care packages which would help normalize the hospitalization process for the pediatric patients at NYU Langone; and

WHEREAS, The care packages included stuffed toys, squishes, coloring books, crayons, stress balls, gift cards, as well as handmade cards that were created by the Mineola High School Student Service Center volunteers; the funds for the project were generated through generous donations and a bottle drive held at the school; and

WHEREAS, His dedication to the safety and well-being of the citizens of Mineola is represented through his project and demonstrates his devotion to both community and commitment to others; and

WHEREAS, Currently a freshman at Hofstra University, Miko Amican is pursuing a degree in engineering, while continuing the ideals and principles of the Boy Scouts; and
