WHEREAS, James Blennau is a member of Boy Scouts of America Troop 45, Mineola, New York; and

WHEREAS, Throughout his Scouting career, James Blennau held the title of Quartermaster twice and a full-year term as Patrol Leader; and

WHEREAS, James Blennau and his fellow Scouts, held a fundraiser in partnership with the East Williston Little League, repaired spots in the

existing basement molding, repainted walls and existing molding, and installed a new chair rail; and

WHEREAS, His dedication to the safety and well-being of the citizens

of Williston Park is represented through his project and demonstrates his devotion to both community and commitment to others; and
