MEMORIALIZING Governor Kathy Hochul to proclaim  
October 23-29, 2022, as Respiratory Care Week in the

WHEREAS, Celebrated annually, Respiratory Care Week highlights the  
information we need to keep us breathing well so we can enjoy a great  
quality of life; and

WHEREAS, Therapists and departments organize events and festivities  
within their workplaces and communities to: celebrate by hosting  
activities to honor and reward respiratory therapists for their

contributions; motivate by encouraging patients and their families in their battles against lung disease; educate by taking awareness of lung diseases like COPD and asthma to the community; inspire by building the desire in others to enter the respiratory care profession; and learn by maximizing personal and professional skills with new resources; and
