WHEREAS, The son of James and Jeanne, Daniel M. Lin is a member of Boy Scouts of America Troop 15, New Rochelle, New York; and

WHEREAS, A graduate of New Rochelle High School, this exceptional young man was Captain of the Quiz Bowl team, participated on the swim team, the Robotics Team, a member of both the Junior States of America (JSA), and the National Honor Society, in addition, Daniel is also fluent in Spanish, having been enrolled in the Children's International Language Academy (CILA), a dual language program, from Kindergarten through High School; and
