WHEREAS, Devoted to her profession, Naomi Klein has been a member of both the Women's Transportation Seminar and the Board of Directors for the New York Public Transit Association and has taught classes on transportation issues at the Scarsdale Adult School; and

WHEREAS, A resident of White Plains, New York, Naomi Klein is looking forward to traveling and spending more time with her husband and three children in her much-deserved retirement; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that those who enhance the quality of life in their community and have shown a long and sustained commitment to the maintenance of high standards in their profession, certainly have earned the recognition and applause of all the citizens of this great Empire State; now, therefore, be it
