Drury is survived by her mother, Leslie (Richard) VanGiesen; father, Philip (Jeanie) Drury; grandfather, John Traeger; siblings, Christopher (Theia) Moyer, Daniel (Ashly) Moyer, Amanda (Steve) Drury, Nicole VanGiesen, and Brett (Kimberlyn) VanGiesen; as well as many aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, and cousins; and
