greatest passion was spending time with her beloved family; and

WHEREAS, Ruth E. Whitfield is survived by her soulmate of 68 years, Garnell W. Whitfield, Sr.; her children, Robin Harris (Philip), Garnell Whitfield, Jr. (Cassietta), Angela Crawley (Melvin) and Raymond A. Whitfield; nine grandchildren; eight great-grandchildren; and five great-great-grandchildren; seven siblings; and a host of cousins, nieces and nephews; and

WHEREAS, Ruth E. Whitfield's infinite selflessness and benevolence will shine on through her family's vivid and happy memories; her insight and strength will forever serve as a beacon of love, light and hope to the countless lives she touched; and
