Wednesday of June; in 2019, the day changed to Global Running Day; and

WHEREAS, Global Running Day is a national initiative of the major
organizations within the running industry to promote running as a
healthy, easy, and accessible form of exercise; and

WHEREAS, From New York to San Diego, the day will celebrate the
benefits of running as part of a healthy and active lifestyle aimed at
combating some of today's most pressing health issues; and

WHEREAS, Individuals from the State of New York can participate in

Global Running Day by simply getting out and running; whether it is with a group or alone, Global Running Day is the perfect time to start fresh with new fitness goals; and

WHEREAS, It is fitting to set aside days which encourage a healthy lifestyle and, in doing so, enhance the health and welfare of the entire State of New York; now, therefore, be it
