MEMORIALIZING Governor Kathy Hochul to proclaim
June 2022, as Immigrant Heritage Month in the State
of New York

strengthen our economy and create jobs in New York State; and

WHEREAS, Immigrants have provided the United States of America and
New York State with unique social and cultural influence, fundamentally
enriching the extraordinary character of each; and

WHEREAS, Immigrants constitute a vital segment not only in our
State's community and economic affairs, but also our State's democracy
and civic discourse; and

WHEREAS, Immigrants comprise more than a quarter of our State's

WHEREAS, Immigrants have been tireless leaders not only in securing their own rights and access to equal opportunity, but have also campaigned to create a fairer and more just society for all Americans; and

WHEREAS, Despite these countless contributions, the role of immigrants in building and enriching our Nation has frequently been overlooked, undervalued and often disparaged throughout history and continuing to the present day; and

WHEREAS, It is imperative that there be greater public awareness and increased recognition of the contributions of immigrant communities at the local, state and national levels; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Legislative Body pause in its deliberations to memorialize Governor Kathy Hochul to proclaim June 2022, as Immigrant Heritage Month in the State of New York; and be it further
