Regional Planning Board and its staff and works with the Board of

Directors to craft the direction of the RPB's programming; she works to secure federal funding for both planning and implementation projects throughout the region, as well as for the Regional Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, Under the able leadership of Beth Gilles, the Lake Champlain - Lake George Regional Planning Board is this year's recipient of the North Country Chamber of Commerce's Economic Development Partner of the Year Award; and

WHEREAS, Over the course of 2021, the LCLGRPB, which represents five counties - Essex, Clinton, Hamilton, Warren, and Washington, helped 209 businesses obtain over \$3 million in loans, as well as using \$5.1 million in grant funding to help communities throughout the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Beth Gilles and the Regional Planning Board utilize local economic development partners like the Chamber of Commerce and other members of the community to prioritize the creation of new projects and programs, always working to better their community; and
