NY Sen. Tom O'Mara: One-party rule in Albany means lack of oversight He says the GOP has been pushed aside by majority Democrats.

"It really boils down to a lack of oversight," Senator O'Mara said. "I don't believe the Legislature is doing its job in oversight of the executive. We have a system of checks and balances, (but) it's one-party rule, and so we're not seeing it."
