SILVER CREEK – In response to the news that the Village of Silver Creek has been awarded a \$1 million Restore New York grant to support the Silver Creek School Senior Apartments project, Senator George Borrello issued the following statement:

"The Village of Silver Creek received an early Christmas gift with today's announcement that a \$1 million Restore New York grant is on the way to help fund the transformation of the abandoned Silver Creek School into affordable housing for area seniors. This is an effort I've championed for more than a decade.
