WHEREAS, Throughout his exemplary career thus far, Bunji Garlin has won numerous Soca competitions and released many award-winning songs, one of which, "Differentology", became one of the NBA's arena anthems and was featured on ABC's "Grey's Anatomy"; and

WHEREAS, Bunji Garlin has been the recipient of numerous awards and accolades for his steadfast and unrelenting commitment to his profession and community; and

WHEREAS, With him throughout have been his wife Fay-Ann Lyons, and their daughter, Syri, both of whom feel privileged to be a part of his life and rejoice in his achievements; and

WHEREAS, This award recipient exemplifies the best of his community, by virtue of his energy, vision, and dedication, commanding the greatest respect among his friends and colleagues, and within the community at large; and
