WHEREAS, Since its inception, Carolyn's Angelz has strived to actively give back to the directly impacted communities of Black and Brown and single mothers and children in her community; and

WHEREAS, Deedra Cheatham has also been actively involved with the Downtown Brooklyn/Boerum Hill Mutual Aid Group, Urban Resource Institutes PALS Program, Constituent Services for NYC Council, Legal Services NYC, and F.U.R.E.E., and tirelessly helped the residents of the Brooklyn neighborhood of Gowanus during the aftermath of Hurricane Sandy; and

WHEREAS, This award recipient exemplifies the best of her community, by virtue of her energy, vision, and dedication, commanding the greatest respect among her friends and colleagues, and within the community at large; and

WHEREAS, It is the custom of this Legislative Body to commend

individuals of outstanding character, who have shown initiative and commitment toward constantly pursuing higher goals for themselves, and acting as role models of leadership to be emulated by both peers and young people; now, therefore, be it
