WHEREAS, In 2004, Reverend Morine A. Bowen-Avery served in the Residency in Ministry program at The Concord Baptist Church of Christ, followed by the Middle Collegiate Church in New York, New York, where she led two mission trips to New Orleans to help rebuild the city after it was devastated by Hurricane Katrina, and served on the Special Commission for the Just Rebuilding of the Gulf Coast; and

WHEREAS, Currently, Reverend Morine A. Bowen-Avery is an Associate Pastor at The Concord Baptist Church of Christ where she blends both her call to ministry and her calling as a social worker; and
