The Saratoga Springs Girls Varsity Cross Country Team captured their second consecutive Nike Cross Country National Championship in Portland, Oregon on December 3, 2022, with

an overall team score of 81 points.

The Blue Streaks also secured the New York State Federation Championship in Wappingers Falls, on November 19, preceded by the New York State Class A Championship on November 12th.
