WHEREAS, Today, Clarence Center Preschool offers childcare for ages 18 months to five years and an after-school program for school age children; and

WHEREAS, For the last 14 years, Clarence Center Preschool has been one of the preschool programs that offer two Universal Pre-Kindergarten programs through the Clarence School District for 4-year-olds; and

WHEREAS, The success of Clarence Center Preschool is in direct correlation to the efforts of its owners Jean and Dale Van Kuren and their staff, whose involvement is, and always has been, characterized by an impressive commitment, an unbridled enthusiasm, and an uncompromising standard of excellence in all endeavors on behalf of the institution and the community it serves; and
