Legislatively Speaking

This week, my fellow Senate colleagues and I passed the 2011 Job Creation and Taxpayers Protection Act.

This measure sets a clear signal about our priorities for 2011 - cutting spending, protecting taxpayers and helping the private sector create new jobs in our community.

Under this plan, businesses will keep the tax withholding on any new job they create (often totaling thousands of dollars). This will allow businesses to invest that money in their own business as they see fit.

The plan also eliminates burdensome regulations that are obstacles to job growth and the corporate franchise tax for hundreds of small businesses with fewer than 50 employees.
