Legislatively Speaking

This week in Albany, I was proud to support my Senate colleagues with the passage of two pieces of legislation which can make our roadways safer for all of us.

Senate Bills S.3452 would create felony charges for wrong-way and other reckless drivers. The legislation would additionally create a crime of aggravated reckless driving for specific offenses.

The Senate also passed S.164C, which would create new penalties for individuals supervising another driver while also under the influence of drugs or alcohol, also known as Abbagail's Law.
