Legislatively Speaking

Earlier this week, I was proud to support my Senate colleagues with passage of legislation that would make it safer for our children who ride school buses.

A bill was passed that increases the penalties for passing a stopped school bus (S.3099A). The legislation would impose a sixty day suspension of a driver's license if convicted of passing a stopped school bus two or more times.

Another school bus bill was also passed relating to "school bus" signs. This legislation would allow for the signs to be constructed with reflectorized materials.
