On Friday, I had the honor of introducing Governor Andrew Cuomo as he <u>outlined</u> his 2012-13 Executive Budget and Reform Plan at the Rochester Institute of Technology. I was pleased to welcome the Governor back to the Rochester area to discuss his Executive Budget with our community. Governor Cuomo has put forward a strong budget proposal that will continue the work we began last year to rebuild New York State from the bottom up. This budget contains no new taxes and fees, provides critical relief to local governments, and invests in major infrastructure projects, including the I-390 Interchange here in Rochester.
