Legislatively Speaking

This week, my Senate colleagues and I passed Michelle and Jordan's Law, which would increase penalties for unlawful high-speed car racing.

The law is named after a 5-year-old Queens boy and a 17-year-old Staten Island girl who were killed as a result of such races.

These races also occur in our back yards. Late Sunday night, Greece Police broke up a drag race on Bellwood Drive. According to reports, at least 100 cars showed up for this race. As a result, two cars were towed away and 75 tickets were issued.
