2012 New Jobs-NY Job Creation Plan

This week, I joined my Senate colleagues in passage of the 2012 NEW JOBS-NY Job Creation Plan. The comprehensive plan will help create thousands of new private sector jobs by delivering tax relief to small businesses and manufacturers, reducing energy costs, and enacting major fiscal reforms to make New York State more economically competitive. Highlights include:

- Eliminating Taxes on New York Manufacturers
- 20 Percent Corporate Tax Cut for Small Businesses
- 10 Percent Personal Income Tax Credit for Small Businesses
- Significant Energy Tax Cut
- New Incentives for Each New Job Created
- Help for New York's Small Brewers
- A new "angel investor" tax credit to encourage investments in start-up businesses.
