Senate Passes Body Piercing Bill

This week, the Senate passed legislation which would require parent or guardian consent for people under 18 who wish to receive body piercings. This would be for piercing of any part of the body, other than the ears.

Of the people with body piercings, more than a third received their first piercing before the age of 18. Body piercings are well-documented to have possible adverse health effects. Some studies have shown complications arising in 25% of all cases. These complications include Valvoline will hold a ribbon allergic reactions, skin infections, scarring, and general discomfort.

Previously, there was no state law establishing any age restrictions on body piercing. While some studios may require written consent before piercing persons under the age 18, many others do not. For more details on this bill, visit my website at www.robach.nysenate.gov.
