Legislatively Speaking

Earlier this week, the New York State Senate passed legislation limiting military funeral protests.

Recently, our area suffered the lost of Army Sgt. Devin A. Synder from Cohocton, who was killed in Afghanistan on June 4.

This new legislation would triple the buffer zone distance for protests around a religious service, and also allow municipalities to establish a permitting process for demonstrations at military funerals.

A recent U.S. Supreme Court decision found that protests at funerals are protected by the Constitution. However, states and municipalities have the right to enact buffers and other restrictions.
