Senate Passes Bill to Prevent Cyberbullying

Legislation Provides School Districts and Parents with the Additional Tools they Need to Address Bullying and Cyberbullying

On Monday, the Senate passed a bill ([S.7740](#)) that would provide further protections and procedures for students who are bullied or cyberbullied. The legislation clarifies and expands the Dignity for All Students Act, an anti-cyberbullying law enacted in 2010, and creates guidelines for local school districts to develop policies and procedures to address the problem. The legislation encompasses those forms of bullying which hinder children's experiences in the classroom and works to create a safer learning environment.

Incidences of cyberbullying are increasing as more and more young people have access to various forms of technology - including social networking sites - both at school and at home. It is important that we work to prevent bullying in order to create a safe learning environment for our children. I remain committed to ensuring that all students have a safe environment in which to learn, free from harassment.
