Governor Signs Three Bills Into Law

This week, Governor Cuomo signed three pieces of legislation, that I was proud to sponsor in the Senate, into law. These new laws include:

- Minors under the age of 18 now need to have written parental consent in order to receive body piercings. These are piercings for any body part, other than the ear.
- High school graduates who achieve proficiency in English and a second language will receive special recognition for their achievement.
- Retirees of Eastman Kodak are able to purchase experience rated health insurance coverage in the event that the company ends health benefits in the future.
