Columbus Day Fun Facts

Monday, we celebrate Columbus Day, which is celebrated on the second Monday in October annually. It commemorates Christopher Columbus landing in the New World on October 12th, 1492.

A number of areas unofficially celebrated the holiday as early as the 18th Century, and the first Columbus Day celebration is said to have been celebrated in 1792 when New York's Columbian Order, or better known as Tammany Hall, held a celebration for the 300th Anniversary of Columbus landing in the New World.

It became a federal holiday in 1937, and was celebrated on October 12th. In 1971, it was moved annually to the second Monday in October.

In many areas, Columbus Day has become a day to celebrate the Italian-American heritage.
