# Senator Adams' Albany News

The Senator serves as Chairman of the Veterans, Homeland Security and Military Affairs Committee and the Racing, Gaming and Wagering Committee.

\* The Senator's Veteran's committee will be considering three nominees to various positions the week of May 18<sup>th</sup>.

\* The Senate passed a Senator Adams-sponsored bill (S.2782) which extends the time for court confirmation of a standby guardian from 60 days to 180 days. This decreases the chance that a ward is left without proper guardianship.

\* There will be two resolutions on the floor of the Senate sponsored by Senator Adams.

- In keeping with Memorial Day, a Resolution to honor the dedication and sacrifice of those who served, currently serve or have fallen in the line of duty as a member of our nation's armed services
- A Resolution commending the brave service of NY State Troopers following an incident in which they successfully secured public safety under great duress.

## <u>CRAIGSLIST CHANGES POLICY AS</u> <u>Senator Adams Confronts</u> <u>Internet criminals</u>

NYS Senator Eric Adams is actively restructuring our laws to keep pace with technology, while websites are rethinking their services.

Senator Adams recently introduced a bill to combat "Internet Related Crimes": transgressions involving persons who commit or abet the commission of a crime facilitated by communicating with the victim over the Internet. The legislation significantly increases criminal penalties for Internet predators. The recent "Craigslist Killer" case highlights the fact that cyberspace has become a medium subject to predatory and even violent criminal activity.

"We must carefully examine and develop appropriate procedures to address and contain this criminal behavior," Senator Adams has stated.

Since Senator Adams' announcement, Craigslist has eliminated its "Erotic Services" category and announced plans to pre-screen "Adult Services" submissions.
