<u>Senator Recognizes Law Enforcement</u> <u>for NYC Foiling Terrorist Plot</u>

NYS Senator Eric Adams commended and congratulated the FBI, NYPD, and NY State Police (Joint Terrorism Task Force) on their remarkable work in preventing a dreadful act of terror against worshippers in our city and against an upstate air national guard base.

The plot targeted the Riverdale Jewish Center in the Bronx and the Stewart Air National Guard Base.

SENATOR SALUTES NYS TROOPERS

NYS Senator Eric Adams introduced a resolution to designate Tuesday, May 19, 2009 as a **Day of Remembrance** in honor of New York State Police.

"On January 10 of this year, our brave State Troopers confronted a perilous situation on Interstate 90," the Senator said.

"Taking immediate and decisive action against the shooter, these courageous officers brought the ordeal to a conclusion in approximately forty minutes, disabling the assailant without a single injury to the public or to themselves."



Senator Adams states:

"The heroes in the NYPD, FBI, and NY State Police achieved a major victory in our ongoing war with Islamic extremists whose immediate goals are the taking of innocent life and the creation of panic and whose ultimate objective is the destruction of our way of life."

SENATE UPDATE

- Senator Adams is co-sponsoring a bill (S.2245) that would increase, for the first time in a decade, the maximum benefit rate for unemployment insurance. If the bill becomes law, the benefit would increase from \$405 to \$475 per week this July.
- The Senator will be co-sponsoring a bill which is a **partnership alternative** to full Mayoral control. Key-sponsored by Senator Huntley, this Parent Commission Bill would call for community input regarding the governance *and* mission of our schools.
