On Tuesday, July 31st, the Monroe County Youth Bureau is hosting their 4th Annual Cardboard City Kick-Off. Cardboard City is an overnight lockout designed to help raise awareness of homelessness in Rochester and Monroe County. The kick-off begins at 3:30 p.m. at Cobbs Hill Park.
