

 Men with a close male relative (father, brother) who had prostate cancer are at an increased risk for being diagnosed with this disease.

 African-Americans have the highest death rate for prostate cancer of any racial or ethnic group in the U.S., 2.4 times higher than in white men.

• Men over the age of 50 are at greater risk for prostate cancer.

 When caught early, the relative 5 year survival rate of prostate cancer is nearly 100%.

This free screening is only for men 40 years old or older who have previously never been diagnosed with prostate cancer. The screening includes a PSA blood test and digital rectal exam.
