



LEGISLATIVE REPORT: Children's Health and Safety

Dear Neighbor,

The health and safety of all New Yorkers has always been my top priority. Since joining the Senate, I have sponsored numerous bills aimed at protecting children from dangerous toxins, including legislation that would remove lead (S.1928) and cadmium (S.4055) from toys, novelty items and costume jewelry, and legislation that established a Children's Environmental Health Advisory Committee (Ch. 178 of 2006) to assist state agencies and schools in removing toxic cleaning agents from our schools.

My bill to prohibit the use of bisphenol-A (BPA) and other phthalates from baby bottles and pacifiers (S.5387) received national attention and has become the model for federal legislation. Also, I previously introduced "Safe Playground" legislation (Ch. 521 of 2002) that eliminated chromated copper arsenate (CCA) from pressure treated lumber once commonly used for playgrounds.

The neurological damage caused by exposure to these chemicals cannot be reversed, and in many cases can cause lasting damage during a child's critical stages of development. Continuing to work with health care and environmental advocates, education groups and parents, I am confident that we can further our efforts to protect our children from exposure to dangerous chemicals and harmful consumer products.

CPR Legislation Introduced

This year, I reintroduced important legislation (S.2491-A) that would require basic cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training in secondary school health education curricula.

Having performed CPR twice before, I am keenly aware how vitally important early intervention is to the survival of cardiac arrest victims. Based on my personal experiences, I have long been a staunch advocate for efforts aimed at increasing the number of individuals trained in CPR. By including CPR instruction in secondary school health curriculum, an entire generation would be armed with the knowledge and skills necessary to save lives.

While the legislation would not certify students in CPR, it would provide students with the basic understanding and invaluable training to perform CPR safely and effectively, increasing awareness of such an important life-saving technique. I am optimistic that this legislation can be the driving force behind more and more people learning CPR and saving more lives.

The URMC Flu Prevention Program, a not-for-profit service offered by the University of Rochester Medical Center, will be onsite to provide flu shots to individuals nine years of age and older. Children ages nine to eighteen must be accompanied by a legal guardian. The team is comprised of professional, experienced registered nurses who are committed to providing individuals with high quality, efficient flu clinics.

The URMC Flu Prevention Program offers direct billing to Medicare and most major insurance plans including Excellus/Blue Cross and Blue Shield, MVP, Aetna, and United Healthcare. Individuals will be invoiced directly if their insurance company does not cover the cost of the flu vaccine.
