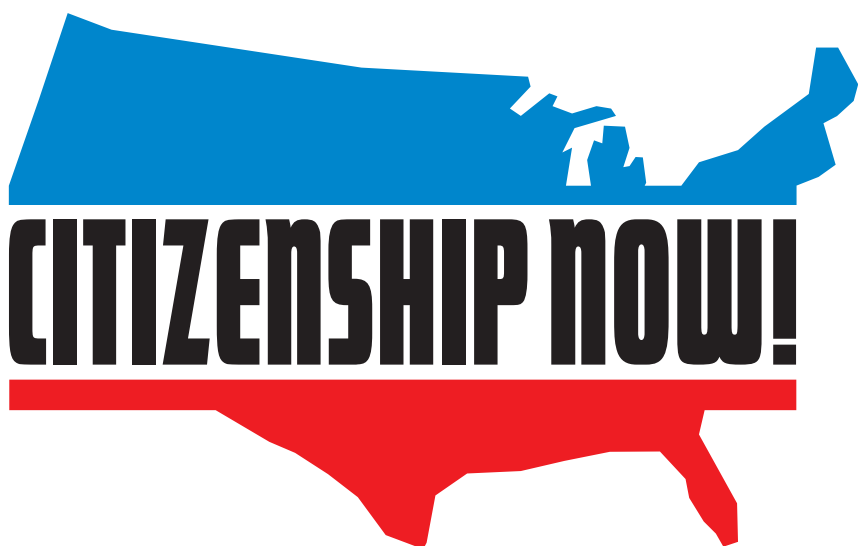

For other immigration issues visit our website and locate a center near you.

Experienced lawyers and other immigration professionals will help you evaluate whether you are ready to apply for citizenship, if you meet the following requirements:

- You have resided in the United States as a permanent resident for five years (or three years if living with and married to the same U.S. citizen)
- You have been physically present in the United States for half of the five or three year period
- You are at least 18 years old

Other factors affect your eligibility.

Please bring:

- Green card
- All passports since obtaining green card
- Marital history*
- Children's information (date of birth, A#, addresses)*
- Criminal history*
- Employment history for the last five or three years*
- Home addresses for the last five or three years

Please note:

The USCIS requires a \$675 filing fee (check or money order), which includes a fingerprinting fee. It is not necessary to bring the fee to this event.

DIRECTIONS VIA SUBWAY: Q local to Avenue H. Walk four blocks east (towards the LaGuardia bell tower) to Ocean Ave. entrance. **VIA BUS:** B6 or B11 to Ave. J, to Bedford Ave. at Campus R.; B8 to Flatbush Ave. at Foster Ave.; B41 to Nostrand Ave.
