ENTRIES

- Entries will be displayed on my website.
- Posters should be submitted on 22" x 28" poster board.
- All entries should be marked clearly and legibly with the student's name, school and grade level so that they may receive credit for their submission.

Due to costs, entries will not be returned. However, entries will be stored until June 1st, during which time arrangements may be made to retrieve them. In addition, the New York State Senate will not be held responsible for entries that are damaged or lost.
