She never denied help to those who asked, and often gave it to those who didn't. She could light up a room with just her smile . . . and show you that things were never as bad as you thought they were. ★ Brooke had the ability to succeed in any endeavor no matter how difficult, but remained modest and humble. She was a voracious reader – reading almost a book each day. ★ Brooke loved to walk, and could always be seen with her water bottle and trusted backpack. Her kindness, beauty, and intelligence will forever be remembered.
