I am writing to request a school crossing guard at the corner of Junction Boulevard and the Horace Harding Expressway in order to ensure that our children cross this hazardous intersection safely on their way to and from school.

As you know, hundreds of children from nearby P.S. 206, the Horace Harding School, cross this intersection every school day morning and afternoon. The P.S. 206 community and local residents are rightfully concerned for the safety of the children and are engaged in a petition drive to call attention to this matter.

Specifically, their primary points of concern are these:

- The age of the students crossing.
- The width of the street and the number of lanes of traffic students must cross.
- Unsafe gaps in traffic.
- The speed of the vehicles travelling through the intersection.
- The high volume of both vehicular and pedestrian traffic at this location.
