

## Holiday Inn open after fire

**ELMIRA** | Five people were treated for smoke inhalation and several rooms were shut down after a fire ignited Wednesday morning at the Holiday Inn Riverview in Elmira.

The fire started around 8 a.m. Wednesday in Room 237, which was engulfed by flames when firefighters arrived. One person was in the room when the fire started.

Elmira Fire Chief Patrick Bermingham said the occupant reported the fire to emergency services, as did the hotel's emergency system.


Investigators believe a faulty heating unit caused the blaze, although no definitive determination had been made as of Wednesday.

"It appears to be accidental," Bermingham said. The room in which the fire started was badly damaged, and several other rooms sustained smoke, heat and water damage. Bermingham said a handful of rooms were closed, although

open and operational. Four of the five victims suffered only minor smoke inhalation, and no one required hospitaliza-

tion, Bermingham said. In addition to the Elmira Fire Department, the Elmira Heights, West Elmira and Southport fire departments responded to the scene.


