March to the Mailbox Day is being used as a point of reference to ask people to send back their completed census forms. The U.S. Census counts every resident in the United States, and is required by the Constitution to take place every 10 years.

The 2010 Census will help communities receive more than \$400 billion in federal funds each year for things like, hospitals, emergency services, job training centers, schools, senior centers, bridges, tunnels and other-public works projects.

## TODAY WE COUNT, TOMORROW WE VOTE

All Census Bureau employees take an oath of nondisclosure and are sworn for life to protect the confidentiality of the data. The penalty for unlawful disclosure is a fine of up to \$250,000 or imprisonment of up to five years, or both. Your personal information cannot be shared with the Internal Revenue Service, Immigration and Customs Enforcement, Federal Bureauof Investigation, Central Intelligence Agency or any other government agency. Not even the President of the United States."
