Sanders Blasts HUD for Turning Sandy Recovery into "Game Show"

April 24, 2014 (**Far Rockaway, NY)-** Senator James Sanders Jr. (D- Rochdale Village) has sent a letter to Secretary Shaun Donovan, Secretary of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") blasting HUD's recent proposal to divert \$1 billion or more of money designated for the rebuilding of the communities impacted by Hurricane Sandy into a nationwide competition for disaster resiliency projects. The money would come from funds diverted from the final \$3.6 billion that HUD has to distribute for Sandy-related projects.

In the letter to Secretary Donovan, Senator Sanders stated, "Every day I witness my neighbors and constituents struggling to recover from the storm.
