You probably have seen the reports of theft at RG&E's Russell Station property and the vandal-caused oil spill where 4,800 gallons of oil spilled from a transformer as a result of this criminal act.

As the clean up continues, I am asking anyone who has any information to come forward and help find those responsible.

Earlier this week, RG&E, in cooperation with the Greece Police Department, announced they were offering a \$5,000 reward to anyone who provides information that leads to the arrest and conviction of the individual or individuals responsible for releasing oil and stealing copper from the spare transformer.
