


It was great to see some of the game and all who came out to honor Al for all he's done and continues to do for the HVAA.

Groundbreaking Ceremony for the Town of Moreau Sewer Extension



Today's Groundbreaking Ceremony for the Town of Moreau Route 9 Sewer Extension is a start to what will deliver many benefits for the community, county, and region. This \$16 million initiative is the largest public works project in the Town of Moreau's history. It will bring for a new era of job creation, tax base expansion, environmental protection, and increase public safety. The sewer project will consist of over 48,000 linear feet of low-pressure sewers and more than 22,000 feet of force main.

As a result of this project, barriers to economic development that has hampered economic growth in Moreau for years will be removed and a major road will be open for business.

Without the municipal sewer service, town and local landlords were unable to close on investments and development opportunities that would help expand and diversify the tax base and bring essential jobs to the community.

Thank you to the leadership of my good friend Todd Kusnierz, Moreau Town Supervisor & Chairman of the Saratoga County Board of Supervisors, for making this project a reality! Also thank you to Sam Whanon, a local business owner, property owner and strong supporter of this important project.

NYS Republican Conference responds to staffing shortages at healthcare facilities



New York's statewide healthcare worker shortage means delayed medical care, and puts an even greater strain on our frontline workers. Burnout from non-stop COVID challenges has hit our healthcare workforce especially hard, and we continue losing the dedicated workers who've courageously served on the pandemic's frontlines. My legislation, S.2553, would create a healthcare worker peer support program modeled after the successful Joseph P. Dwyer Program. My bill would deliver support and funding to empower healthcare workers to speak with someone who's shared their experiences and can help provide counseling. A healthcare worker peer support program is a smart solution to address this serious, growing challenge.




