






Antisemitic Incidents - New York State








What is S 895?

- Transparency bill similar to California's AB 587, signed into law by Governor Newsom last year
- Requires social media companies to post its terms of service and submit disclosure reports to the state Attorney General














 Social media companies should have clear and accessible policies about online hate and harassment

• The reports would also include **changes** that companies make to their policies






Reports we can read

• Reports should be **easily understandable**

• Published in a **central location** for the public





• Reports will include how many users/groups were flagged for violations

• Disclosure of the number of actions taken and how the company responded

Accountability

• Users will be able to see how companies agree to respond to online hate

• Data about online incidents will be public
