
You have the power to change the world around you! This coloring book shows a few ways people can come together to make a difference.

STRIKE


A strike is when workers all *stop* working in order to pressure their bosses to make changes. Bosses are powerful, but they can't do anything without workers -- so when all the workers stand together, the workers have the power!

While striking, workers usually stand or march in a circle in front of the workplace with picket signs -- this is called a "picket line."




MUTUAL AID

Mutual aid is when people in a community work together to directly meet each other's needs. We all have different abilities and resources, but together we can build stronger neighborhoods where all of us have what we need.



MARCH

Marches and other forms of demonstrations can help draw attention to an issue or show strong support for a potential solution. These work best when they are tied to a specific demand.
