My New Legislation to Protect Taxpayers



In the wake of Governor Cuomo's outrageous attempt to nickel-and-dime New Yorkers by requiring them to spend \$25 to purchase new license plates, I've introduced legislation to help prevent this from happening again! My new Senate legislation, Senate Bill S.6746, would set a limit for the issuance of license plates to \$1.50 above the actual cost of the plates, rounded to the nearest twenty-five cents. My bill would protect taxpayers from paying a fee that's arbitrarily set and completely unjustifiable given our already crushing tax burden and high cost of living.
