We are writing to you on behalf of all of our constituents, as well as those who have contacted our office regarding construction signs inscribed "Men Working" surrounding the Henry Hutchinson Parkway and Lincoln Avenue in District 34.

As women continue to work as hard as ever to establish themselves in male dominated fields, it is this nuanced signaling that can inhibit growth and inclusion in the workplace. Verbiage on a construction sign may seem like a small detail, but it speaks to a larger sense of how we view these industries and those who are welcomed there. Gender specific signs also perform as a means to further marginalize those who identify as non-binary and gender non-conforming. We would like to ask that the Department of Transportation phase out the usage of "Men Working" signs and implement gender neutral signs such as "People Working".

We respectfully request that the Department of Transportation review this request and take action and movements forward to make both the Department and the State of New York a more inclusive space.
